The New Covenant for the Church is BETTER Than the Old Covenant of Law (pt 2)

Scripture Reading:

Hebrews 8:1-13

INTRODUCTION

Paul is encouraging these Jewish Christians to let go of attempting to live their daily lives by observing the old covenant of Law, and to embrace the <u>better</u> covenant which provides ETERNAL LIFE for their daily living.

He demonstrated that Christ, as a better high priest, has therefore become a guarantee of a better covenant (than the covenant of Law) – Heb 7:20

Paul continues to reinforce his argument of "a better covenant" in Hebrews chapter 8.

A Summary of the Superiority of High Priestly Ministry of Christ (Hebrews 8:1-6)

♦ His High Priestly ministry is more excellent because:

 He is <u>seated</u>, indicating that His sacrificial offering ministry is <u>finished</u> – vs 1, 7:27; cf I Jn 1-2

♦ Where He is seated – vs 1; cf Jn 16:8,10

♦ He ministers for us in the true heavenly tabernacle - vs 2

 His ministry does not consist of offering temporal, annually-repeatable gifts and offerings - vs 3-4; cf 7:27

♦ His ministry consists of mediating a <u>better</u> covenant – vs 6

The Superiority of the Better Covenant Which is Activated upon Better Promises (Heb 8:6b)

The promises of the 4th Abrahamic Covenant

- A singular "Seed" = Jesus Christ
- In whom ALL nations would be blessed –Gal 3:8-9, 27-29

Being placed into our position in Christ activated the provision of New Covenant for the Church: Eternal Life for the gracebeliever

Israel's FUTURE New Covenant is Used to Show an **OT Promise of** Superiority to the Old Covenant of Law

 Hebrews 8:7-13 ESV
⁷ For if that first covenant had been faultless, there would have been no occasion to look for a second...

In speaking of a new covenant, he makes the first one obsolete. And what is becoming obsolete and growing old is ready to vanish away.

CONCLUSION

Three covenants are mentioned in Hebrews 8
the better covenant (the one for the Church, vs 6)
The Old Covenant of Law for Israel
The New Covenant of Law for Israel, vs 7

♦ Rom 11:5,7 – the remnant of Israel, who were elect by grace

One body, the Church, made up of saved Jews and Gentiles, living by means of Eternal Life from the Better Covenant
