The New Covenant for the Church is BETTER Than the Old Covenant of Law (pt 4)

INTRODUCTION

Paul's letter o the Hebrew Christians was to encourage them to let go of their continued attempts to keep the demands of the covenant of Mosaic Law and embrace the God-provided eternal quality of Life in the New Covenant for the Church.

INTRODUCTION

The New Covenant for the Church

- Referred to twice as a "BETTER covenant" Heb 7:22, 8:6
- Referred to twice as a "NEW covenant" - Heb 9:15, 12:24

The New Covenant for Israel, YET FUTURE

- Referred to twice Heb 8:7-13, 10:15-18
 - Both references are used by Paul in order to illustrate that the Old Testament foretold that the Mosaic Law covenant would be replaced!

Three Reasons Why the New Covenant for the Church is <u>Better</u> that the Old Law Covenant

#1

It is a guaranteed covenant

- Heb 7:22

- Guaranteed to provide an uninterrupted High Priesthood
 - Heb 7:21, 23-24
- Guaranteed to provide <u>complete</u> salvation
 - Heb 7:25



Three Reasons Why the New Covenant for the Church is <u>Better</u> that the Old Law Covenant

#2

It has <u>activation</u> by better promises – Heb 8:6

- The promise to Abraham of a singular Seed
 - = Christ
 - Gen 22:17, Gal 3:16
- The singular Seed would bless all the nations
 - Gen 22:18, Gal 3:27,28

Three Reasons Why the New Covenant for the Church is <u>Better</u> that the Old Law Covenant

#3

It can cleanse the conscience from 'dead law works' in order to serve a living God

- Heb 9:12-15

- This cleansing applies to those NT believers who were living under OT Law, i.e., Jewish believers
 - cf Rom 6:14, 4:15

Two Reasons Why Paul Mentions The New Covenant to Israel in The Letter to the Hebrew Christians

To show these Jewish Christians that their OT Scriptures foretold of a replacement covenant for the Mosaic Law covenant - Heb 8:7-8, 13

To give a second OT witness to the "taking away" of the Mosaic Law covenant

Two Reasons Why Paul Mentions The New Covenant to Israel in The Letter to the Hebrew Christians (continued)

The problem:

- the OT animal sacrifices could not
 - Cleanse the conscience (of dead law works)
 - Could not take away sin Heb 10:1-4

The solution:

- 1st witness Ps 40:6-8
- 2nd witness Jer 31:31-34 summarized
 - God's provision of a human body for His Son in order to be the "once for all" consummating, final sacrifice for sin
 - cf Heb 10:5-10 (notice vs 9!)

The conclusion:

Heb 10:18!

CONCLUSION

This encouraging exhortation is primarily directed to <u>Jewish</u> Christians who are <u>transitioning</u> from living under the old Mosaic Law covenant, to living under **New Covenant for the Church**.

However, Gentile believers need to be aware of the danger of stunted spiritual growth and fruitlessness by <u>putting themselves</u> under OT Law to live the Christian life - Gal 3:1-4
