REVIEW of the Definition of a COVENANT

A Biblical covenant is a 'super promise' by God to individual in order to provide "strong consolation" - Heb 6:16-18

A Biblical covenant is only a covenant when the BIBLE calls it a covenant!

Once a Biblical Covenant is made it cannot be added to or subtracted from - Gal 3:15

REVIEW of COVENANTS

♦ The more notable and important covenants in Scripture: the nation of Israel \otimes 1 made with David (the promise of a future king) ♦1 to be made in the future

REVIEW of COVENANTS

- The more notable and important covenants in Scripture:
 3 covenants that pertain <u>only</u> to the Church
 The New Covenant belonging to the Church that provides Eternal Life to individual NT grace-believers
 The 4th Abrahamic Covenant that promised a singular Seed: Christ

INTRODUCTION

This morning we will emphasize the 'blueprint' of that assured glorification of the Church: <u>the</u> <u>4th Abrahamic Covenant:</u>

a promised singular Seed from Abraham and all those placed into that singular Seed -Christ.
