

Positionally Dead AND Alive in the Colossian Epistle (continued)

Scripture Reading:

Romans 8:1-7

INTRODUCTION

Christian apologist (one who speaks or writes in defense of a point of view) Ravi Zacharias, had a podcast called "Let My People Think!"

- I Cor 2:16 "For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ"
- A local church sign that is displaying Romans 8:1 "There is no condemnation to those who belong to Christ" (KJV "...to the ones in Christ Jesus")

Orin Bidwell's article submitted to the Baptist Bulletin, "The Two Sides of 'In'" (based on John 14:20), was rejected by the editor for being "too deep" for the average reader of the magazine

Positional truth of our salvation is NOT too deep. It is for every believer to know and understand

Vs 1 - The risen Christ sitting at God the Father's right hand

- "IF" is a Greek first-class condition which means "assumed to be true" from the viewpoint of the speaker or writer. In this instance, the viewpoint of Paul
- Therefore, "IF" in vs 1 = "SINCE it is assumed to be true" and, also in
 - "SINCE we were buried with Christ" Col 2:20
 - "SINCE we were raised with Christ" Col 2: 12-13
- Then, "(mentally) seek those things above"
 cf Eph 1:3

Vs 2 – Focused thinking on "above" things - The "mind of Christ" cf | Cor 2:16 "For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ."

Vs 3 - Because you are dead - not physically or spiritually, BUT positionally - cf Jn 3:6-7

- Your (positional) LIFE, i.e., resurrection life, is "hid with Christ in God" – Col 2:1-3
 - Our treasures: the wisdom and (experiential) knowledge of our position in Christ
 - Don't let anyone rob ("spoil" KJV) you of these treasure! - Col 2:8

Vs 4 - Our position will be made a permanent reality at the appearance of Christ for the Church, the Rapture –

"… but we know that, when He shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as He is"

I. Elements of the world system = material goods, commerce, food production (worldly education, religion, entertainment (music, art, theater, sports, etc) Col 2:20-23

- 2. Satan is the designer, engineer, and director of the world system - Jn 12: 31, 14:30, 16:11
- 3. The purpose of the world system:
 - To direct the sin nature in ways acceptable to society
 - To misdirect the attention of believers from "things above, not the things on the earth" - Col 3:2, I Jn 2:15

4. The believer's relationship to the world system
 We are to live in it, while here on earth Jn 17:15

We are not <u>out</u> of it, as to our source
■ Jn 17:16, cf Jn 3:7

We can <u>use</u> the world system, but not "mis-use" i.e., it to its fulness
I Cor 7:31

5. Therefore, we are crucified to the world's control and the world's control over us is crucified

 Gal 6:14 "But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world"

 6. The dogmatic restrictions of the world system that come form man-made asceticism and religious legalism – Col 2:20-22

- Prohibitions from this asceticism & legalism -vs 21

 These prohibited elements are destroyed (consumed) by their very use - vs 22a

 These restrictions come from commandments and didaskalia from the men (ascetics, legalizers) vs 22:b, cf I Tim 4:1-4

 The failure of false restrictions of the elements from the world system – vs 23

CONCLUSION

Every NT grace-believer who has this hope should

- "Purify themselves," that is, be free from the taint of our three spiritual enemies
 - I Jn 3:3 kjv "And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself just as He is pure"
- Know that Christ in us is the hope of our position in Him (the glory)
 Col 1:27 kjv "To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory"
