### INTRODUCTION

- "Just Do It!"
  - Under Mosaic Law, men were to 'just do the right thing by their own personal effort
  - But the list of <u>actions</u> of proper relationships in Col 3:18-4:1 is preceded by divine enablement of "Christ in you and you in Christ"
    - cf Col 1:27

 Phil 1:27 reveals that "I can do all things (all the works of Eph 2:10) by means of the One strengthening me – Christ"

### **Provided Enablement**

- Our position in Christ is our new identity!
  - •Col 2:11-13 Buried, raised, alive in Christ

- The place to set our focused thinking
  - •Col 3:1-3

### Planned Behavior (Col 3:5-17)

Putting to death - "putting off" - the <u>behavior</u> of the Old Man (vs 5, 8-9)

Putting on the behavior of the New Man (vs 12-15)

"Allow the Word (discourse) of the Christ dwell in you (your thinking) abundantly" (vs 16)

Summary of this planned behavior: "Do all things (in word or deed) in the name (character) of the Lord Jesus..."

"...while giving thanks to God the Father"

## Produced in Actions (Col 3:18-4:1)

- Marital words and works (vs 18-19)
  - Wives to husbands:
    - Submit for the benefits of his headship/leadership

- Husband to wives:
  - Do love them
  - Don't be bitter toward them

## Produced in Actions (continued) (Col 3:18-4:1)

- Family words and works (vs 20-21)
  - Children to parents: vs 20
    - "Obey" literally 'to listen under', 'pay attention unto action'
      - "In all things" (that are righteous)
      - "That is well-pleasing to the Lord"
  - Fathers to children: vs 21
    - Do not stimulate to discouragement, passionlessness
      - Be fair and understanding with rules, regulations, and requirements

### Produced in Actions (continued) (Col 3:18-4:1)

- Workplace words and works: vs 22-25
  - Employees to employers:
    - "Obey" literally, to listen under, pay attention unto action
      - "In all things" (that are righteous)
      - "Not with man pleasing eye-service"
      - "But with fear" (of missing out on God's best)
      - Proper motivation: we co-inherit with Christ (Rom 8:17)
  - Employers to employees: vs 4:1
    - "Providing that which is just and equal" (to their rendered service)
    - "While knowing your Master in Heaven is dealing righteously and equitably with you"

### CONCLUSION

 We can only actively perform these righteous relationships of Colossians 3:17-4:1 as we <u>consistently</u> remember and then <u>utilize</u> our salvation (us in Christ and Christ in us)

 'Just Do It' - through our graciously provided relationship with Christ and NOT in our own strength
