INTRODUCTION

We live in an era of an overwhelming abundance of knowledge; aka "The Information Age"

As human beings, no one can take in, process, and remember all the knowledge that inundates us!

Therefore, we <u>must</u> be elective in the knowledge on which we focus and remember.

The NT grace-believe must focus on the most vitally relevant and eternally important knowledge, which is God's written revelation: the Bible

As we move into a new year, we need to be reminded of four of the most basic realities for our lives as Christians:

Remember the God of Eternal Life: Jesus Christ is our Life – Col 3:4a

Remember the words of the Life: The words from Christ and the Apostles

Remember the people of the Life: remember fellow believers in prayer, material assistance, and to love one another

Remember to put this Life into practice

THE FOUNDATION FOR THE PRACTICE OF ETERNAL LIFE (II Peter 1:1-4)

♦ Faith for initial salvation – vs 1

THE FOUNDATION FOR THE PRACTICE OF ETERNAL LIFE (II Peter 1:1-4)

The freely given gift of all things that pertain to life and godliness – vs 3

Glory – God's good and accurate opinion of us in Himself

Virtue – The character of the Life Christ's displayed, in we can now participate

THE 7-FOLD PROGRESSIVE DISPLAY OF ETERNAL LIFE (II Peter 1:5-7)

Supply VIRTUE
Christ-like character to your initial faith – vs 5a

Supply EXPERIENTIAL KNOWLEDGE

concerning our 3 spiritual enemies. USING God-provided defenses
IN our experiential knowledge – vs 6a

THE 7-FOLD PROGRESSIVE DISPLAY OF ETERNAL LIFE (II Peter 1:5-7) continued

♦ Supply GODLINESS -

♦ well-devotedness; Lordship (Rom 12:1-2) to Christ – his Lordship, plans, and provisions IN our patience – vs 6c

Supply BROTHERLY LOVE – (an emotional expression of desire for one another's well-being) IN your well-devotedness to God – vs 7a

Supply AGAPE LOVE - (desiring and providing God's best for another believer) IN your brotherly fondness – vs 7b

THE POSITIVE PRESENCE and DISATROUS ABSENCE of the PRACTICE OF ETERNAL LIFE

♦II Peter 1:8-9 NKJV

♦For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins" ENCOURAGEMENT to PRACTICE ETERNAL LIFE WHILE HEADING for the ENTRANCE of THE ETERNAL KINGDOM BELONGING to OUR LORD and SAVIOR JESUS CHRIST

♦II Peter 1:10-11 NKJV

♦ for so an entrance will be supplied to you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ"
