### INTRODUCTION

 Memorial Day (originally "Decoration Day"), began on May 30<sup>th</sup>, 1868

 \$5000 participants decorated the graves of the 20,000 soldiers buried at Arlington National Cemetery

It came to include the memorial of all fallen US soldiers from our conflicts and wars.

Finally, it became a day if remembrance for all families to remember their dead loved ones.

### INTRODUCTION (continued)

**♦** The NT grace-believer is not encouraged to focus our remembrance on death, but on life – **ETERNAL LIFE! ♦ We are to remember: ♦** The God of this LIFE **♦** The words of the LIFE ♦ The people of the LIFE

# Remember the Words of this Life

The Holy Spirit would cause them to remember the words, and <u>understand</u> the words - Jn 14:26

The words of the apostles were to be remembered - II Pet 3:1-2

 $\otimes$ "...we heard, and we are still hearing..."

 ${\boldsymbol{\circledast}} Not$  to neglect reminding them

Reminding them, while yet living in his "tent"

Peter's desire for them to remember "these things" <u>after</u> his exodus (KJV demise)
