The Present Condition and Result of Israel's Temporary Blindness

Scripture Reading:

Romans 11: 7-15

INTRODUCTION

Previously, we've examined the question of why there is renewed world-wide antisemitism today.

In answering that question from Scripture, we've come to understand Israel's beginning, their glorious future.

Today, we continue to look at Romans 11 to understand their situation for the last twenty centuries until the present Romans 11:1-6 There has ALWAYS been a remnant of Israel that is chosen to salvation by God's grace!

Israel's Present Condition of Spiritual Blindness Romans 11:7-10

Israel has not obtained righteousness by means of working for it – vs 7a, cf Rom 10:3

But the elect obtained righteousness by means of faith in the gospel – vs 7b, cf Rom10:4

Israel's Present Condition of Spiritual Blindness Romans 11:7-10 (continued)

The unbelieving of Israel were hardened ("blinded" KJV) – vs 7c-8, cf Isa 6:9-10, Matt 13:10-15

David's prophecy of this blindness – vs 9-10, cf Ps 69:20-25

The Result of Israel's Temporary Spiritual Stumbling Romans 11:11-14

Israel's "stumbling" is not permanent – vs 11a

 Israel's stumbling is a result of the "trespass/offense" ("the fall" KJV)

 Israel's stumbling <u>has resulted</u> in the offer of salvation to the Gentiles – vs 11b

The Result of Israel's Temporary Spiritual Stumbling Romans 11:11-14 (continued.1)

- This offer of salvation <u>results</u> in stimulating Israel to be zealous for the things of God –vs 11c
 - cf vs 14 Paul's desire to stimulate those Jews who are elect by grace, to be zealous unto salvation by faith in the gospel - cf Acts 13:42-45

 Israel's stumbling <u>has resulted</u> in (true) riches for the world and Gentiles

The Result of Israel's Temporary Spiritual Stumbling Romans 11:11-14 (continued.2)

- Israel's fulness (unto salvation –cf vs 26) will provide the world and Gentiles greater riches yet!
 Euture topse salvation for today's grace believers – vs 12
 - <u>Future-tense salvation</u> for today's grace believers vs 12b

• Vs 13 is Paul's authoritative explanation of Israel's stumbling and recovery for the benefit of the Gentiles understanding

The Result of Israel's Temporary Spiritual Stumbling Romans 11:11-14 (continued.3)

• Vs 15 – the <u>results</u> again stated:

Provisional reconciliation of the world to God

Israel's future reception by God is going to result in "life from the dead" = The resurrection of OT believers at the beginning of Christ return and millennial reign
of Dan 12:2-3, 13

CONCLUSION

Israel's temporary blindness and being cast away has resulted in the riches of salvation being provided to the whole world and will ultimately result in the fulness of their salvation and the resurrection of the Jewish believers from the OT era.

How should these present and future realities affect our daily lives as NT grace-believers?
