



OUR EARTHLY SAVIOR'S 'TO-DO' LIST: **FULFILLED**

Scripture Reading:

Hebrews 10: 1-10

Luke 24: 36-46

INTRODUCTION

- When planning a trip, it is a necessity to develop an itinerary and a packing list, i.e., destination, activities, necessities to bring
- God the Son's trip to Earth was totally planned by His Father.
 - His itinerary was to do the Father's will – Heb 10:7
 - What He was going to Do and SAY – Jn 9:4, 12:49
 - His 'packing' consisted of a 'prepared' (adjusted) body through which to accomplish His itinerary – Heb 10:5

FULFILLED: THE NECESSARY EARTHLY MINISTRY OF CHRIST (John 4:34)

- “I must be about my Father’s business” Lk 2:49
- “I must preach...” Lk 4:40-43
- “I must go through Samaria” Jn 4:4
- “I must abide at thy house” Lk 19:5
- Christ’s Earthly ministry is then, finished Jn 17:4

FULFILLED: CHRIST'S NECESSARY CROSS-WORK (Matt 16:21)

“He must go to Jerusalem –
Lk 13:33



He must suffer many things



He must be killed - cf Jn 3:14



His cross-work on behalf of our
sins was then finished – Jn 19:30

THE NECESSARY BODILY RESURRECTION OF CHRIST (Luke 24:5-7)

- Lk 24:5-7 - Two angels reminded the women who came to the tomb that the Son of man must be delivered, crucified, and rise the third day
- Lk 24:25-27 - The risen Christ reminding the two on the Emmaus Road that the OT Scriptures foretold His suffering and resurrection (glory)
- Lk 24:38-46 - the risen Christ reminding the Eleven in the Upper Room that the OT Scriptures must be fulfilled
- Jn 20:3-9 - Even Peter and John did not yet know the OT Scriptures that Jesus must rise again out from dead ones
